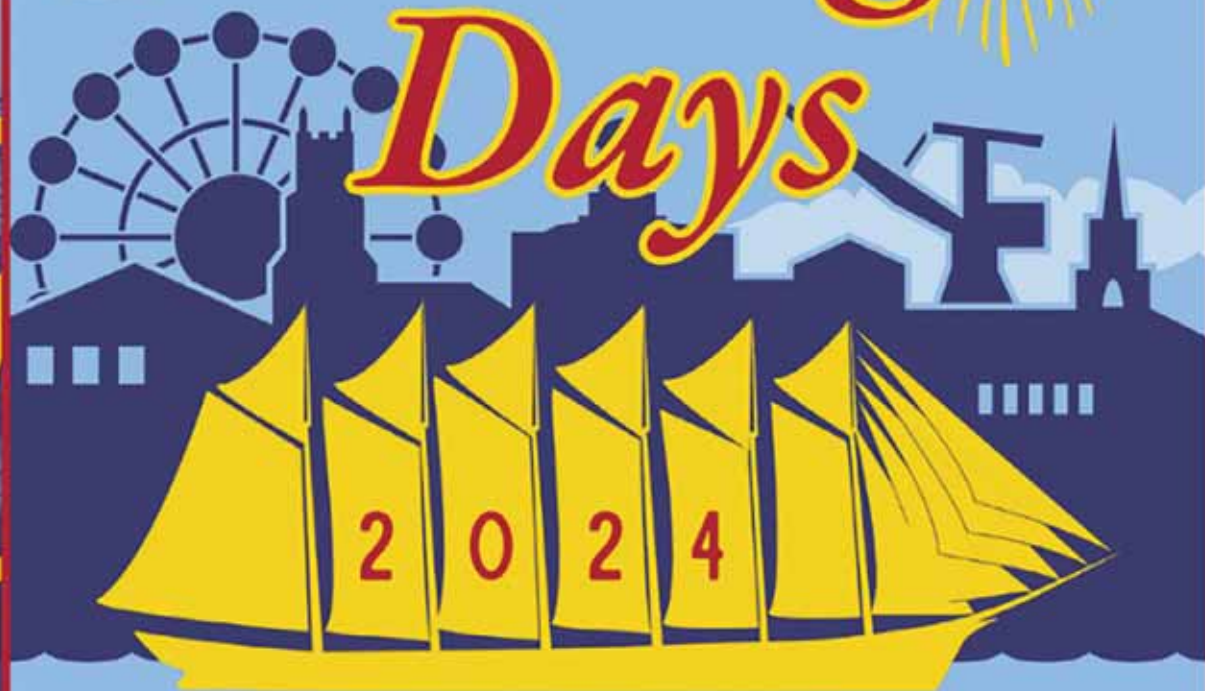

WHAT A TIME TO BE ALIVE as we gear up for the 50th Anniversary of Bath Heritage Days!

Established in 1972, and considering the two-year break for COVID, this is the year we can count as the 50th festival celebration of Independence Day.

Starting out with a bang on Thursday, July 4, you can expect all the traditions we've come to know and love on America's Birthday: the Road Race, Independence Day Parade, Strawberry Shortcake social and fireworks.

All the beloved elements will return: local food trucks, J.R. Maxwell & Co. beer garden, Smokey's Greater Carnival & Games and Bill King's Front Street Shuffle Antique Car Show.

Art in the Park is up from 40 to 50 vendors this year, in honor of our anniversary. Gazebo musicians will be playing as you peruse the Friends of the Library book sale.

Speaking of anniversaries, this will be the 175th Firemen's Muster! Don't miss the fierce competing "hand-tubs" with the rush of water and clanging bells.

Live Music on the Main Stage this year has the returning Pat Colwell & the Soul Sensations and Papa Tim & The Whiskey Throttle Band. We also have new talent: The Smith Collaboration, Breakin' Strings, the Back Woods Road Band and more.

Kids Day, run by Kid's Under Ground and Bath at Play, will host free crafts and lawn games for littles, which is a fun, non-carnival alternative for families. Later, the Portland Reavers will be showing off their swordsmanship!

Main Street Bath has worked for ten months to fundraise, plan, organize, schedule and market this event. A staff of two and a team of volunteers run this great party.

Register online at bathme.myrec.com. The first 50 online registrants for the 5 mile will receive a road race t-shirt. Online registration closes Monday, July 4 at 3 p.m. After that, you must register in-person from 6:15 to 7 a.m. at Bath City Hall.

The fun run is non-competitive. Each participant’s time will be recorded and results will be posted, but individual awards will not be given out.

The five mile road race will award 1st place medals for top male and female finishers overall, and in several age categories from 14 and under to 70 and up.
